

FAQ – Foreign Nationals

1/ Question:

What documents are required to be submitted with an application for temporary residence for the purpose of business?

Answer:

When submitting an application, the following documents must be provided:

- **A Business Plan or a Business Plan for the Implementation of an Innovative Project,**
- **Supporting documentation,** such as:
 - preliminary contracts (e.g., a contract on a future agreement, lease agreement, supplier agreement, or customer agreement),
 - an overview of education,
 - relevant certificates and attestations,
 - proof of proficiency in the Slovak and English languages.

2/ Question :

What documents are required to be submitted with an application for renewal of residence,

Answer:

The applicant must provide:

- identification details (address, company identification number, tax identification number, etc.),
- a description of the business activity performed,
- an overview of education, certificates, and attestations,
- financial statements for the previous accounting period,
- lease, supplier, and customer contracts,
- price lists and business cooperation agreements,
- invoices or a summary of invoices for the previous billing period,
- records of the number of employees,
- proof of proficiency in the Slovak and English languages.

3/ Question:

Where can I find a template for a business plan or for a business plan aimed at implementing an innovative project?

Answer:

Templates are available on the website of the Ministry of Economy of the Slovak Republic,

4/ Question:

Is there currently a programme for foreign nationals to invest in the Slovak economy that would enable them to obtain a residence permit in the Slovak Republic?
