Project idea:

Development of a common and open state(regional) data model (DataMOD)

Description:

One of the biggest challenges that all the EU countries are facing currently is the implementation of the **new EU data strategy** and the **subsequent regulations**. Since the strategy aims to position Europe as the global leader in data economy, we are faced with many challenges that are related to the development and implementation of standardized procedures that regulate the way we work with data to make it interoperable across different sectors/regions.

From a practical perspective this is very much connected to the development of the common EU data spaces that will work in accordance with common rules and standards.

Project aims at helping European regions to shape their policies to better development of data model.
