Better governance (policy objective 6) / Policy governance

Project summary:

People in small communities have the same needs and rights for accessible and quality public services as people living in large ones, but less opportunities. It's the duty of local governments to meet these needs and grant these rights. It's also the Government's duty to ensure the necessary framework in which local governments have the basic instruments they need to do their job. Capitalization of cooperation gains is a solution to succeed when you can't do it alone, especially in areas as digitalization, where technologies and needs advance so fast. Thus, the project aims to improve policies on cooperation so local governments, partners or theirs target group, become stronger by sharing experiences, resources and tools, by joining efforts to provide good practices, inspiration and trust to others facing the same challenges. Disparities between communities could thus be reduced and accessibile and quality public services become reality. Our partnership connects national, regional and local perspectives and partners's experiences (amalgamation in LV and FR, intercommunity and agreement actions in FR, cooperation within the county in HR and varied cooperation forms in RO) allowing know-how sharing and will inspire new ways to improve policies, enabling an integrated approach on cooperation. Exchanges of experiences, mutual learning and on-the-ground cases will spark all partners to boost their policies, on common roots and goals, and to build a better future for their communities. The framework to be improved by the leader with significant input from the partners will have a national impact on small local governments. The ROP to be improved by the MA partner will ensure more focused financing. The policies improved by the other partners will have a direct and quick impact on the corresponding communities. Issue addressed by your project

The measure falls within specific objective 6 - better governance - which aims at developing and improving tools to support governance processes at local level and to enrich the policies and their implementation in order to ensure the necessary conditions for an open, participatory, inclusive and responsible governance, able to provide quality services that meet the evolving needs of the beneficiaries. The project focuses on analysing existing cooperation solutions and how they can represent a support tool to overcome the obstacles that small local communities face in providing quality public services to citizens, seeking to improve these tools by capitalizing on the experiences and best practices. This will increase the institutional capacity of public authorities, both those directly mandated to manage a certain territory, as well as those with a coordination role at a higher level (county, region, national) to build, manage, implement or finance policies of regional development.

Project's overall objective:

The project's overall objective is to improve the implementation of regional development policies in the field of better governance, in particular to enrich project's various policies or their management by emphasizing cooperation forms that will support local governments to better meet the communities' needs and the funders' requests. The project will capitalize on areas of fruitful cooperation, forms of

cooperation and their financing or merger of authorities, with a focus on certain specific areas as provision of electronic public services. The partners' diverse practices in this area makes this project the perfect frame for a change in the mindset and organizational culture in the benefit of partners and their stakeholders, and also in the benefit of others who can adapt or replicate the experiences or get inspired in finding new solutions. Cooperation will become a more widespread way of doing things that can strengthen local communities in any EU country.
